It was known as the *Journal of the Western Pacific Orthopaedic Association* from 1962 to 1992. The current title—*Journal of Orthopaedic Surgery*—was adopted in 1993 to reflect the expanding geographical boundaries of an international readership of over 1,200.

Members of the APOA include: Australia, Bangladesh, China, Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Myanmar, New Zealand, Pakistan, Philippines, Singapore, Sri Lanka, Taiwan, Thailand, Turkey, and Vietnam. Fully trained orthopaedic surgeons who are members of the APOA are entitled to receive one copy of the Journal. Other subscribers include hospitals, orthopaedic centres, medical libraries, and individuals in non-member countries.
